Assignment Three – Art Review

Due Date: Thursday, March 13th

There are 2 parts to this assignment.

Part One

Your assignment is to write a reflection about 1 piece of creative work that **inspires** you as an artist. You must include either an image or an Internet address that connects to the work with your response.

1. Who created the work?
2. What is the work about?
3. Why did you choose this work?
4. When did you first learn about the work?
5. How has the piece influenced your work or process as an artist?
6. How do you feel when you interact with the work?

Part Two

Your assignment is to write a reflection about 1 piece of creative work that **challenges** you as an artist. You must include either an image of or an Internet address that connects to the work.

Who created the work? What is the work about? Why did you choose this work? When did you first learn about the work? Has this work influenced your creative process as an artist?

Your assignment must be single spaced using 12-point font. Your first and last name must be clearly marked on all assignments.

Assignment Four – Peer Review

Due Date: Thursday, March 13th

You will write a reflection responding to a piece of work created/ performed/ exhibited by one of your peers. This must be a piece of work created by someone outside of your major. Remember, you are the audience.

You may use the following questions as guidelines when writing your response:

1. Describe the piece you have chosen.
2. What is the work about?
3. Who has created/ performed the work?
4. Why have you chosen this particular piece for the assignment?
5. Discuss a minimum of 2 strengths of the work.
6. How does your personal creative process relate to the work you have chosen? For example, you might have similar interests, motivations, etc.
7. What did you contribute as a member of the audience? In essence, how did you contribute to the performance/ exhibition of the work?

Your assignment should be approximately 1 1/2 pages in length. It must be single spaced using 12-point font. Handwritten assignments will not be accepted.

Your first and last name must be clearly marked on all assignments.
